STOPPING BY A BRANCH?

To open a checking account in person, you'll need:

- ☐ Personal information, including address, phone number, and Social Security number.
- ☐ Two forms of identification (ID)
- ☐ Primary ID such as Massachusetts Driver's License, Massachusetts issued ID Card, Passport or Passport Card.
- □ Secondary ID such as student ID with photo, major credit card, utility bill, or US Military ID card.
- ☐ Money to fund your new account. You can use a current account from another bank, credit or debit card, or cash.

APPLYING ONLINE?

To open a checking account online, you'll need:

- ☐ Personal information, including address, phone number, and Social Security number.
- ☐ Identification, such as a driver's license, state ID, passport or military ID.
- □ Account and routing numbers or a credit card number to fund your account.


